Cyprus, Greece**

Congratulations to Roy Elzur, Eitan Jaffe, and Matthew Cohen of the 7th grade, and freshman students Yael Nahum and Einav Nachman recently admitted to the competitive Euromath 2009 Research Symposium (www.euromath.org), held February 5th in Cyprus, Greece.

Capitalizing on expertise honed at TVT's Annual Research Conference, students refine their projects in groups; working on research at UC Irvine and contacting corporations with specialties in their field. Nahum and Nachman will present their research *Deformities in Infants and Mathematical Formulas*, while Elzur, Jaffe, and Cohen will explain *The Golden Ratio, Fibonacci Sequence and the Stock Market*.

As part of TVT's project-based curriculum, students engage issues holistically, exploring their implications in a multitude of fields. Math instructor, Alla Korinevskaya, who holds a Masters in Mathematics from Kiev University, Ukraine as well as a Masters in Education from UC Los Angeles, believes that project-based research allows students to participate in cutting-edge mathematics, "synthesizing information across a variety of fields, while learning to communicate clearly both verbally and in writing." Beyond this, the opportunity to travel to Greece will help these students witness the global implications of their work, an important tool for success in the 21st Century.
