COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL

Tarbut V'Torah is a non-affiliated pluralistic Jewish community day school that offers a spectrum of diverse opportunities for students interested in pursuing challenging academic studies in a Jewish setting. TVT groups its students through a system of thirteen houses, known as "tribes."

The lower school was founded in 1991. The campus opened to freshman in 1997. The first graduation took place June 13, 2001. All divisions are WASC and

CAIS accredited through 2012. Tarbut V'Torah is also a member of the National Association for College Admission Counseling and complies with the NACAC Statement of Principles of Good Practice.

Irvine, California is one of the nation's largest planned urban communities, a city of 202,079 in Orange County. Most of the residents are engaged in academic, business, managerial, or professional work.
